BYLAW NO. 1985 - 2

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF LAMPMAN, IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN, FOR THE PURPOSE OF REDESIGNATING THE PUBLIC RESERVE R1 IN BLOCK 1, PLAN NO. 76R03962.

WHEREAS notice was given by publication thereof in the PRAIRIE PROGRESS, a weekly newspaper circulating in the Town of Lampman, in the Province of Saskatchewan, in the issues of December 12th and December 19th, 1984, of the intention of the Council of the Town of Lampman to redesignate the Public Reserve Rl in Block 1, Plan No. 78R03962, to be consolidated with Lots 1 to 4, inclusive, in Block 1, as a parcel to be sold for commercial use.

AND WHEREAS the provisions of Section 156 & 157 of The Urban Municipality Act have been fully complied with and no person has claimed that his land will be injuriously affected thereby, nor petitioned the Council to be heard in connection with this Bylaw;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Lampman, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. THAT the Public Reserve Rl in Block 1, in the Town of Lampman, Province of Saskatchewan, Dominion of Canada, as shown on a Plan of Record in the Land Titles Office for the Regina Land Registration District as No. 78R03962, be redesignated and consolidated with Lots 1 to 4, inclusive, in Block 1, as a parcel to be sold for commercial use.
- 2. THAT the Director of the Community Planning Branch, Department of Urban Affairs, Province of Saskatchewan, be and is requested to convey title for the said Public Reserve Rl as contained in Paragraph 1 hereof, to the Town of Lampman.

THIS BYLAW shall come into force and have effect from and after the final passing thereof.
