BYLAW NO. 2006-2

GENERAL PENALTY BYLAW

A Bylaw of the Town of Lampman, in the Province of Saskatchewan, to establish penalties for contravention of bylaws.

The Council of the Town of Lampman, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw may be referred to as the "General Penalty Bylaw".
- 2. "Municipality" means the Town of Lampman.
- 3. Section 4 shall apply only with respect to an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality for which no other penalty is provided.
- 4. Every person who contravenes any provision of any bylaw of the municipality is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction:
 - in the case of an individual, to a fine not exceeding Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars and, in the case of a continuing offence, to a further fine not exceeding Two Thousand, Five Hundred (\$2,500.00) Dollars for each day during which the offence continues; and
 - b. In the case of a corporation, to a fine not exceeding Twenty-five Thousand (\$25,000.00) Dollars and, in the case of a continuing offence, to a further fine not exceeding Two Thousand, Five Hundred (\$2,500.00) Dollars for each day during which the offence continues.
- 5. Bylaw No. 2000-7 is hereby repealed.
- 6. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the 1st day of January, 2006.
