BYLAW NO. 2013-2

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF LAMPMAN TO ESTABLISH PROPERTY TAX PENALTIES

The Council of the Town of Lampman, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. Due Date

Property and other taxes imposed by the Town of Lampman are deemed to be imposed on the first day of January in each year and shall be due on December 31st.

- 2. Penalty on Arrears of Taxes
 - (a) Taxes which remain unpaid after the 31st day of December of the year in which they are levied shall be subject to a penalty;
 - (b) The method of calculating the penalty shall be a simple rate of one (1%) percent per month, added on the first day of each month to the total taxes, excluding any penalties previously added, that remain unpaid at the end of the month preceding the month in which the penalty is being applied;
 - (c) The penalty charges are to be added to and shall form part of the tax roll.
- 3. <u>Repeal Previous Incentive Program</u> Bylaw No. 2008-4 is hereby repealed.
- 4. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon final passing thereof.
