BYLAW NO. 2015-9

A BYLAW TO CONTROL THE USE OF FIREWORKS WITHIN THE TOWN OF LAMPMAN

The Council of the Town of Lampman, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. The setting off of fireworks within the limits of the Town of Lampman is prohibited, except as provided written permission is first obtained from the Council of the Town of Lampman.
- 2. i. Clubs and Organizations may hold displays of fireworks within the limits of the Town of Lampman, provided written permission is first obtained from the Council of the Town of Lampman.
 - ii. Individuals may hold displays of fireworks within the limits of the Town of Lampman for special occasions such as anniversaries and weddings, provided written permission is first obtained from the Council of the Town of Lampman and the individual shall contact the fire department.
- 3. Anyone violating the provisions of this Bylaw shall be liable for each offence to a fine of not less than one hundred dollars (\$100.00), and not more than two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00).
- 4. This Bylaw shall come into force and effect upon the final passing by the Council of the Town of Lampman.
- 5. Bylaw 2015-7 is hereby repealed.
