BYLAW NO. 2017-10

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF LAMPMAN, IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN, REGARDING SNOW REMOVAL WITHIN THE TOWN LIMITS

The Council of the Town of Lampman enacts as follows:

- 1. The Town of Lampman shall remove snow from town streets anytime following a snow fall in a timely manner. Access to the Lampman Fire Hall, Lampman Community Health Center, and Lampman School shall be priority. All residential and business districts shall be as time permits, at the operator's discretion.
- 2. The Town of Lampman may remove snow from back alleys or lanes as a secondary priority at the operator's discretion and/or as time permits.
- 3. Ratepayers are not allowed to remove snow from private property onto the drive portion of any roadway, alley or lane. All snow removal from private drive, or lanes, sidewalks, or private property must be placed on the owners or occupant's own property.
- 4. Any person who contravenes the provisions of this Bylaw is guilty of an offence and shall be liable to a fine under the General Penalty Bylaw of the Municipality
- 5. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon the final passing thereof.
