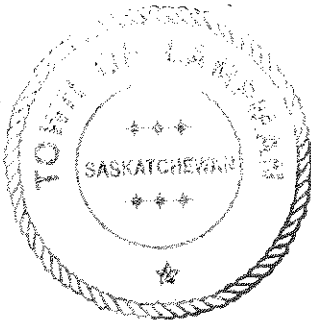


BYLAW NO. 1982-2

**A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF LAMPMAN TO EXTEND THE PERMITTED USE OF  
PLASTIC PLUMBING MATERIALS**

Under the provisions of Section 83 of the Public Health Act,  
R.S.S. 1978, the Council of the Town of Lampman enacts as follows:

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Saskatchewan Plumbing and Drainage Regulations, 1978, enacted under the Public Health Act, the Town of Lampman and the Rural Municipality of Browning No. 34 of Lampman, in the Province of Saskatchewan, is hereby authorized to use plastic pipe and fittings in the plumbing system serving the structure known as the Recreation Complex, located on Block Y and Z in the Town of Lampman.
2. The construction of such plumbing system shall be subject to and meet all requirements that may be imposed by:
  - a) The office of the Provincial Fire Commissioner, and
  - b) All other provisions of the Saskatchewan Plumbing and Drainage Regulations, 1978.
3. This Bylaw shall come into force and effect upon approval of the Minister of Health.
