

BYLAW NO. 2006-17

**A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF LAMPMAN TO
ESTABLISH ASSESSMENT APPEAL FEES**

The Council of the Town of Lampman, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

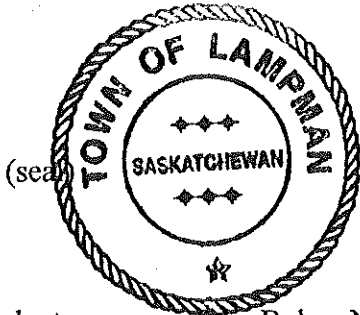
Pursuant to Section 224 of *The Municipalities Act*, an Assessment Appeal Fee shall be required for a ratepayer appealing his or her assessment:

1. The Assessment Appeals Fee shall be Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars per parcel of property.
2. Where the Appellant is successful in whole or part, on an assessment or classification appeal at either the Board of Revision or the Saskatchewan Municipal Board, the Assessment Appeal Fee shall be refunded.
3. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon final passing thereof.
4. Bylaw No. 97-1 is hereby repealed.


