Online Banking

Your utility account number as a four-digit number to identify your payment:

Ex. Acct. #54 would be 0054.

*****SPECIAL NOTE*****

Due to the Town Office being closed to the public because of **COVID-19**, we will accept online payments for general, tax and utility accounts until the office re-opens. **You MUST notify the office (either by phone or email) if the payment is for something other than utilities or how you want the payment applied.** If you do not notify this office of where you want the payment applied, it will be applied as follows:

- 1st – utilities
- 2nd – general accounts
- 3rd - taxes

Operation of Vehicles

The following are a few excerpts from the current operation of vehicles bylaw (Bylaw No. 2016-12):

- * The speed limit within the Town of Lampman is 40 km/hr, unless otherwise posted.
- * No vehicles (including campers, trailers, etc.) may be parked in any one place for 24 hours or more.
- * No parking within 10 metres of any intersection or fire hydrant.


Sump Pumps

REMINDER to All Property Owners



It is the responsibility of every property owner to keep your property clean and esthetically pleasing. Ensure your grass is cut and weeds are taken care of, and remember to cut your grass along your fence and up to the back alley.



PET OWNERS

It is the responsibility of all pet owners to ensure that **ALL** pets (DOGS & CATS) are properly restrained to your own property or on a leash **AT ALL TIMES** and **NOT allowed to run at large.**

It is also the **pet owner's responsibility** to not allow your pets to bark, howl or cry loudly or excessively and you must clean up all feces after your pet if you are off your property.

All pets **must** have a Town of Lampman pet licence. **These pet licences are good for the life of the pet.** *If your pet loses the tag you will have to purchase another tag for that pet.*

Estevan Humane Society will not accept any animals from Lampman and area as they are generally at or beyond their capacity. For this reason, any pets caught at large will be impounded and transported to the Regina Humane Society. Any and all costs for the transportation and retrieval of these pets are the sole responsibility of the pet owner.



*****Building Permits*****

If you are planning any new construction or renovations to your property (**including decks, fences, etc.**), you require a building permit **PRIOR** to any construction commencing. Contact the Town Office for more information and to fill out a building permit application.



*****Lagoon Update*****

The new lagoon is completed and operating!!! Finishing ground work around the lift station will occur once the weather permits.



Lampman Waste Transfer Station

All waste **MUST** be placed in the proper bins.

Permitted:	Not Permitted:
- household waste	- cement
- white metals	- tires
(water heaters, appliances, etc.)	- building demolition material

Minimum charge for a load	- \$10
Pickup truck/utility trailer	- \$30
1 ton truck	- \$90
Furniture & Appliances	- \$10 ea



Hours of Operation:

April 1 to Oct 31	- Tues 3 - 7 pm	- Sat 10 am - 4 pm
Nov 1 to Mar 31	- Sat 10 am - 1 pm	

The compost area is for tree branches, garden refuse, leaves & grass clippings **ONLY!**

NO GARBAGE or LUMBER

Remove leaves & grass clippings from garbage bags before dumping.
